Occupational Safety and Health Board sets Anchorage hearings

JUNEAU—The Alaska Occupational Safety and Health Review Board has scheduled five days of hearings August 22-26 in Anchorage to consider challenges filed by employers contesting citations issued by the Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development.

Citations are based on alleged violations of state occupational safety and health standards filed by the Division of Labor Standards and Safety.

The hearings will begin daily at 9:00 a.m. in room 209 of the Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development offices at 3301 Eagle Street.

Advance hearing notices are provided to all parties of contested citations. Board hearings are open to the public as required by Alaska statute.
