DOLWD Issues First Contractor Licensing Civil Fines

(Juneau) – The Division of Labor Standards and Safety in the Alaska Department of Labor & Workforce Development has issued the first contractor licensing civil fines under the new law from House Bill 81, which was signed into effect by Governor Frank H. Murkowski on June 21. In July, the Division issued a \$1,000 civil fine to an unlicensed contractor operating in the Sterling and Soldotna areas, and two more contractors were cited in August.

Under the new law, first time violations of Alaska's contractor licensing laws (AS 08.18.011 or AS 08.18.025) result in a \$1,000 civil fine and subsequent violations are subject to a \$1,500 civil fine. The existing criminal penalties remain in effect and will be applied to significant violations.

“This new law gives us a tool to deal with individuals who ignore the law,” said Labor & Workforce Development Commissioner Greg O’Claray.

Contractor licensing laws are designed primarily to protect consumers. Critical elements of the contractor licensing process require an applicant to provide proof that they have liability insurance, a bond to cover problems with their work and workers’ compensation insurance if they have employees.

“We hope this enforcement effort sends a clear warning to individuals who work in violation of contractor licensing requirements,” said Labor Standards and Safety Director Grey Mitchell. “It’s simply unfair to reputable businesses that provide the necessary bonding and insurance to protect their customers to allow unlawful competitors to continue operating without penalty.”
