Alaska Federal Unemployment Extended Benefits End Oct. 11

JUNEAU, Alaska—Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development Commissioner Click Bishop announced today that Alaska's federal unemployment Extended Benefits will end with the last payable week being Oct. 11. However, federal Emergency Unemployment Compensation is still available to qualified workers.

The Extended Benefits program triggered off because Alaska's total unemployment rate for the latest three month reporting period fell below 110 percent of the same periods in either of the last two years.

The department's Employment Security Division administers the unemployment insurance program. Alaskans who are currently filing for EB will be notified of the programs' end and of their potential eligibility to continue receiving benefits under the EUC program.
