

Sources for graph and tables: Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development, Research and Analysis Section; and U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics Alaska's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate fell one-tenth of a percentage point in September to 6.8 percent, according to the Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development.

The rate has been bumping around by statistically insignificant amounts since May without showing a clear trend up or down.

The U.S. unemployment rate was unchanged in September at 6.1 percent, a pause in what has been a clear upward trend for more than a year. The rate has climbed 1.7 percentage points since its cyclical low of 4.4 percent in March 2007.

Alaska's estimated payroll job count in September was 333,900, an over-the-month decline of about 8,000 jobs as the state's seasonal industries began to wind down for the year. Seafood processing jobs fell by 4,400, accommodations by 1,900, food services and drinking places by 1,600, and retail trade by 1,500.

Partly compensating for the seasonal declines was a typical increase in state and local government education jobs at the beginning of the academic school year.

Alaska continues to show over-the-year job growth, although the growth rate appears to have slowed slightly. The number of payroll jobs grew by 1,600 from September 2007 to this September. The driving force behind most of that growth continues to be the oil and gas industry.

By comparison, the number of U.S. payroll jobs in September was down nearly 600,000 from September 2007. Seasonally adjusted payroll job numbers for the country show a decline of 760,000 jobs from a high point of 138.1 million in December 2007.
