Effective 7/22/2013, the Division of Workers' Compensation began accepting reports of occupational injury and illness, compensation reports, and controversion notices via electronic data interchange (EDI) transmission using release 3 industry standards developed by the International Association of Industrial Accident Boards and Commissions (IAIABC).

All trading partners – insurance companies, self-insured employers, claims administrators – must register with the Division's vendor, Insurance Services Organization, by completing a trading partner profile. Registration is done online at <http://www.adoledi.info/>.

Trading partners can register to submit EDI transactions directly; submit EDI transactions through an approved EDI vendor; submit EDI transactions online using the ISO/ADOL web entry portal, or elect to continue filing directly with the Division by paper.

To accommodate the new reporting system, the following reporting forms have been modified:

- Employee Report of Occupational Injury or Illness to Employer ([form no. 07-6100](#))
- Employer Report of Occupational Injury or Illness to the Division of Workers' Compensation ([form 07-6101](#))
- Compensation Report ([07-6104b](#))
- Controversion Notice ([07-6105](#))

Use of the revised forms becomes effective 7/22/2013.

Employers should submit their completed forms to their insurer or claims administrator, who will in turn submit the forms on to the division.
