Occupational Safety and Health Review Board Sets Anchorage Hearing

JUNEAU – The Alaska Occupational Safety and Health Review Board has scheduled a hearing Aug. 27 in Anchorage to consider challenges filed by employers contesting citations issued by the Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development.

Citations are based on alleged violations of state occupational safety and health standards filed by the Division of Labor Standards and Safety.

Anchorage hearings will begin at 10 a.m. on Aug. 27, in Room 402 of the Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development at 1016 W. Sixth Ave. and will continue through Aug. 28 as necessary.

Advance hearing notices are provided to all parties of contested citations. Board hearings are open to the public as required by Alaska statute.
