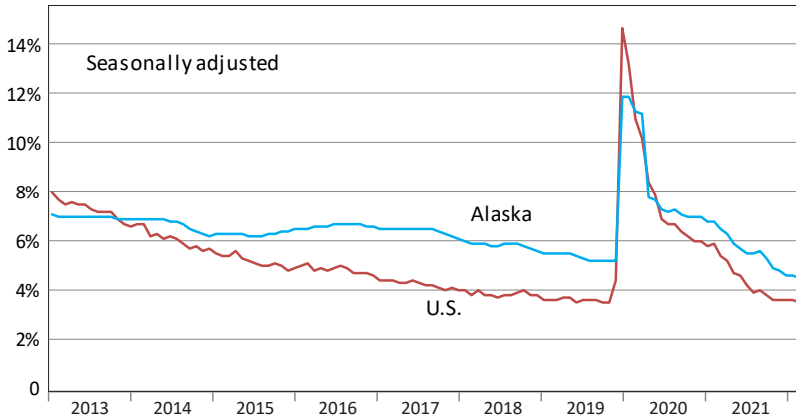


Unemployment Rates, Alaska and U.S.

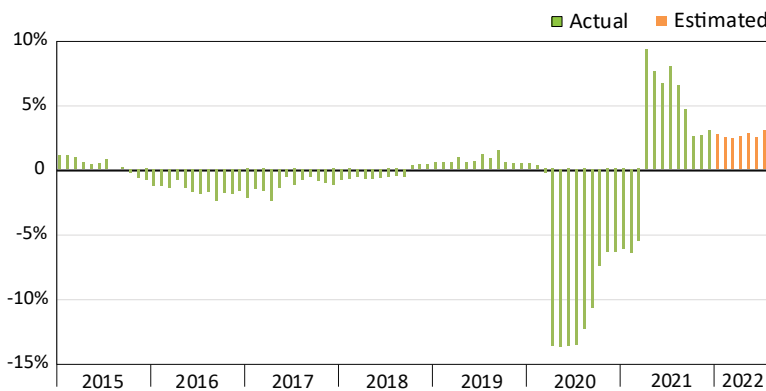

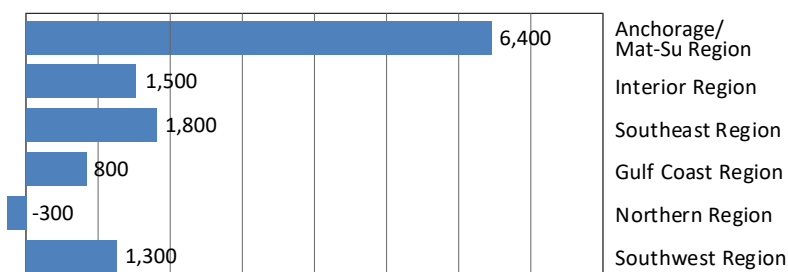
Percent change from same month the previous year

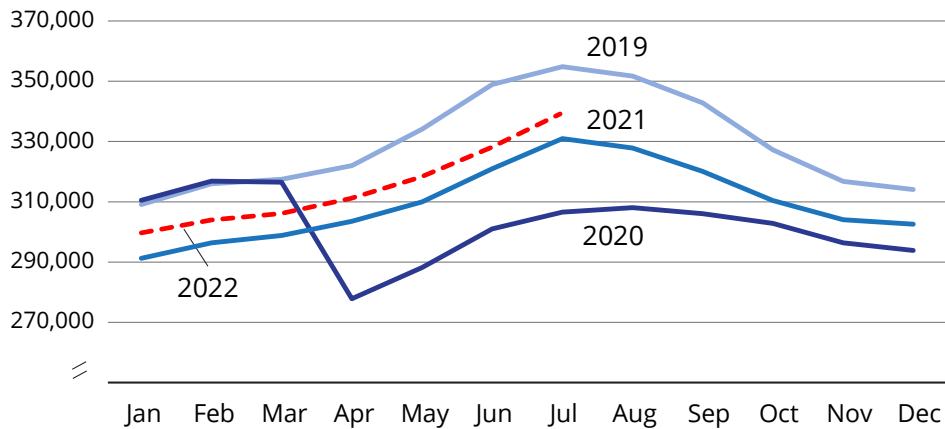
